<b>Week 1</b> 10-14 July	Poetry To identify what poems always, sometimes and often have. Eg. Poems are always fiction or nonfiction.	Poetry To create a cinquain poem. Eg. Snow Lovely, white Falling, dancing, drifting Covering everything it touches Blanket	/le/ as in table Eg. able, circle and comfortable.	Money To give change to the nearest 5 cent value. Eg. If you have \$5 and spent \$3.75 you would get \$1.25 change.
<b>Week 2</b> 17 - 21 July	Poetry To explore the features of different types of poetry. Eg. Haiku poems have 3 lines, with a pattern of 5-7-5 syllables.	Poetry To create a limerick and haiku poem. Eg. There once was a man from Peru, Who dreamt that he swallowed his shoe. He woke up in a fright In the mid of the night To learn that his dream had come true!	/ <b>g</b> / as in giant Eg. gem, giant, generous.	Addition and subtraction  To break numbers to 10,000 into thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones to solve addition and subtraction problems.  Eg. 8524 can be written as 8000+500+20.
<b>Week 3</b> 24 - 28 July	Thinking and talking about books To explore ways to express thoughts and opinions about texts. Eg. Giving your opinion about a text using evidence to justify your thinking.	Sentence structure To create sentences that have a subject and a verb. Eg. The <u>cat</u> (subject) was <u>chasing</u> (verb) its tail.	/se/ as in horse Eg. case, horse and purposeful.	Mapping To create and read simple grid maps. Eg. Explain how to move from C4 to E5 using grid references.
<b>Week 4</b> 31- 4 August	Giving a book talk  To share my knowledge and understanding of a text.  Eg. The author's message was that you should always treat others kindly.	Using paragraphs To understand when to use a paragraph in a piece of writing. Eg. Paragraphs are used to begin a new idea.	/a/ as in mask and /al/ as in half Eg. mask, faster, basketball. Eg. Half, calves, calming.	Graphing To collect data and display it using a digital graph. Eg. Creating a pie chart or bar chart to display collected data.
<b>Week 5</b> 7 - 11 August	Literature circles To work in a team to read and comprehend a text. Eg. Taking on the role of 'summariser' and summarising a text for your group.	Using paragraphs To understand when to use a paragraph in a piece of writing. Eg. Paragraphs are used to begin a new idea.	/ear/ as in ear Eg. ear, nearly, disappear.	Multiplication and division To explore strategies for multiplication and division. Eg. 2+2+2+2 is the same as 2x4.
