Take Home Readers

The take home books will begin coming home from Monday 6th February. These are meant to be 'easy to read books' for your child. This is so your child can build their **fluency, accuracy** and **confidence** when reading aloud. Please fill out the reading log book each night with the date and title of book read. The green case will come home with them each night and should be sent back to school every day. **Please only record one book per night.**

We encourage you to aim for **5 nights of reading a week** – 1 book per night (approx. 10mins)
If your child is tired, we suggest sharing the reading with them, line by line or page by page.
